

# HONEYBERRIES



## *Lonicera kamchatica*

Native to Eastern Europe and Japan, this extremely hardy and adaptable member of the honeysuckle family produces delicious fruit with a flavor and color reminiscent of blueberries. It is easy to grow and has very few disease or pest issues. The dark blue, cylindrical fruits are believed to be high in antioxidants and beneficial phytochemicals. This handsome shrub boasts fragrant white flowers in spring, followed by flavorful berries in early summer. One of the only fruit bearing plants for part- to full-shade! Plant two different varieties to increase yields.

## VARIETIES for 2017

<b>BLUE FOREST</b>	A compact variety at 3' tall and wide, Blue Forest boasts attractive, large, deep green foliage and tasty fruit. A reliable producer for the Pacific Northwest.
<b>BLUE HOKKAIDO</b>	Very popular in Japan, featuring upright habit and good yields of extra-large, sweet-tart, crisp, flavorful, dark blue fruit.
<b>BLUE MIST</b>	Produces abundant crops of large, flavorful, sweet-tart berries. A handsome shrub, it features a spreading form and dark green, velvety foliage.
<b>BLUE MOON</b>	A compact, spreading shrub with deep green foliage and good crops of large, dark blue fruit that is well adapted for our climate.
<b>BLUE PACIFIC</b>	At only 3', this variety is perfect for smaller spaces, yet it still produces large yields of deep blue, delicious fruit.
<b>BLUE PAGODA</b>	Maturing at 4-5', this attractive late blooming variety yields crisp, sweet fruit with excellent flavor. Good pollinator for Blue Velvet.
<b>BLUE SEA</b>	Handsome, low growing variety with spreading habit and high yields of juicy, large fruits. Good pollinator for Blue Velvet, Blue Moon, and Blue Pacific.
<b>BLUE VELVET</b>	One of the most ornamental cultivars with attractive gray-green foliage on 4'-5' plants, produces berries with well balanced sweet/tart flavor.
