GOLDEN CLUB

Velvety dark olive leaves with silver underside, unusual flower spike of white and yellow!



FLOWERS: Unusual white flower spike with yellow tip, May-June

LIGHT: Part sun to shade

SOIL/SITE: Wet soil, to 6" submergence

HABIT: 6-10"h x 18+" w, nice clumping form

ZONE: 5-11 Native to U.S.

WATER HAWTHORN

Attractive bright green floating leaves, Sweetly scented edible flowers!



FLOWERS: Sweet scented blooms in spring, a break in summer, again in fall

LIGHT: Afternoon shade - dappled sun

SOIL/SITE: Submerge to 8" overwinter deep in pond

HABIT: 12"h x 24"w

ZONE: 6-10 overwinter in deeper water
