SANTOLINA

Grows in mounds, forming a tall groundcover. A profusion of varying shades of yellow flowers, leaves are gray, soft and slightly aromatic when crushed.

- PRUNING:** Prune in autumn. Pruning will encourage new spring growth.
- CULTURE:** Plant in full sun, well-drained soil. Drought tolerant once established.
- GARDEN USES:** Forms a low border or edging good for shaping. It's an excellent, gently rolling groundcover.
- KITCHEN USES:** A perfume oil is extracted from the leaves. Flowers used in arrangements. Used in Eastern medicine.
